**Meeting Minutes Review/Approval:** The minutes were approved as corrected.

### Old Business:

- 2006 VA Run -Jim is proceeding with plans for this race next year.
- The Turkey Trot Predict will serve as a test race for chip timing.
- Reserve account at Wells Fargo will be used for future equipment purchases.
- Equipment insurance. Report from Bill Gallegos. Reviewed the equipment inventory. A motion was made for PPRR to apply to RRCA for equipment insurance. The motion passed. The estimated replacement cost for equipment is \$22,953.66. According to the insurance policy, it doesn't matter where the equipment is stored, at the storage shed, or at a member's house. The premium will be est. \$250.
- Pat has invited Tony Shockency, new to the Downtown Y, to attend a board meeting when his schedule permits.

### New Business:

- ADTM fund usage. Larry made a motion to use some of the profits from ADTM to support Kids Races at PPRR Fall Series. The Kids Race would then be free. The motion passed.
- Shoe Drive - John O'Neill and Colorado Running Company are having a shoe drive for Hurricane Katrina victims. Donations of all types of shoes can be dropped at all 3 area running stores. Vans from Phil Long will deliver the donations.
- Nominating Committee - Pat asked Jack Anthony to head the Nominating Committee. Al Grimme, Larry Miller, Cymmie Bailey also agreed to serve. They will set a meeting date before they leave tonight's meeting.
- Fall Series Dinner/ Annual meeting. YMCA Multipurpose Room has been scheduled for the Fall Series dinner/ annual meeting. Crackers catering will be arranged by Pat.
- Jack Anthony discussed strategies to take advantage of community interest in running before and after a major race. Running clubs should strategically remind folks that they are a group who could support their continued interest. Even though we wouldn't be directly involved with or a sponsor of a particular race, we can encourage participation and in turn it supports local running and our club.

**Treasurer's Report:** Gil Kindt - The full report was accepted and is on file. Total bank accounts, \$18,642.25.

**Event Promotion:** Al Grimme reported that information for the Fall Series, kids and adults, and the CC Tiger Classic 5k race are posted on Active.com.

**RRCA:** Jack Anthony previewed a few subjects for future historical articles for the newsletter. He is still trying to schedule a visit Lisa Paige from RRCA and is also researching how we submit newsletters to RRCA for annual awards.

**Certifications/Measuring:** Travis Waldrip reported that the ADTM received a new certificate because of re-measuring due to Colo. Springs Utilities work at the South turnaround. The PPRR Great Race - 5K will use start and finish of ADTM 5k.

**Calendar:** Corrections to the September calendar were submitted to Dave Sorenson.

**Equipment:** Larry Miller asked if anyone knew where the second distance measuring wheel was hiding. Several present thought that it might be in possession of John O'Neill. 2 new canopies were purchased for \$89/each. Discussion followed concerning the 737 timing devices. The have become unreliable. Larry made a motion to replace 2 Chronomix 737 for \$1500. The motion passed. Larry and Bill Gallegos will work together on that purchase. Dave asked if he could borrow a chrono on Monday nights for kids racing events. The board approved.

**Volunteer Coordinator:** Cymmie is still missing volunteer hours for the Pikes Peak Ascent/Marathon and the American Discovery Trail Marathon.

**Race Coordinator:** Manitou Springs Mayor's cup is not cancelled. The Run Pikes Peak group will direct the race. It will be a low entry fee, no shirt race. Dave will take the cancelled notice off of the website and the calendar.
